Free Printable List of the Catholic Ten Commandments (Deuteronomy 5:5-22):

I [Moses] was the mediator and stood between the Lord and you at that time, to show you his words, for you feared the fire, and went not up into the mountain, and he said: "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage..."

1st Commandment: You shall not have strange gods in my sight. You shall not make to yourself a graven image or idol.

2nd Commandment: You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.

3rd Commandment: Observe the day of the Sabbath, to sanctify it.

4th Commandment: Honor your father and mother.

5th Commandment: You shall not kill.

6th Commandment: You shall not commit adultery.

7th Commandment: You shall not steal.

8th Commandment: You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

9th Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.

10th Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's possessions.

These words the Lord spoke to all the multitude of you in the mountain, out of the midst of the fire and the cloud, and the darkness, with a loud voice, adding nothing more: and he wrote them in two tables of stone, which he delivered unto me.

Jesus' New Commandment

As the Father has loved me [Jesus], I also have loved you. Abide in my love. If you keep my commandments, you shall abide in my love: as I also have kept my Father's commandments and do abide in his love. These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and your joy may be filled. This is my commandment, that you love one another, as I have loved you.
